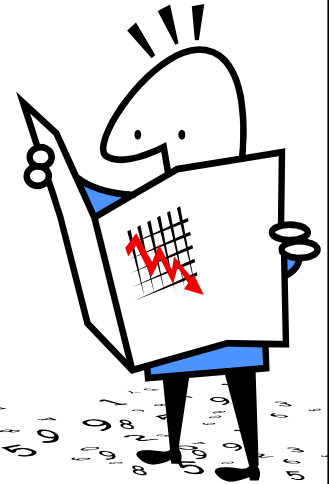




Ontario Chapter News – April 2009
