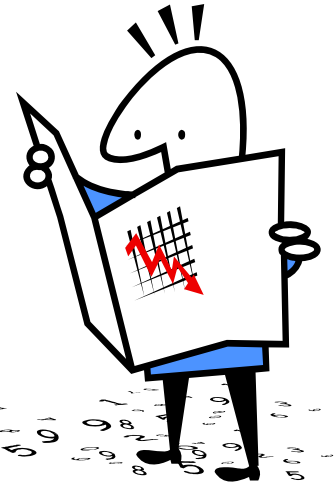




## Ontario Chapter News – June 2009
